

Bayer Fund - Hawaii Science Education Grant

Helping to nurture the education of Hawaii's youth

The Bayer Fund - Hawaii Science Education Grant helps to provide our public schools with programs, tools, supplies and equipment to enhance quality education for our youth, and encourage today's students to consider a future career in the sciences. Schools, teachers and parent-teacher associations are invited to apply.

General Guidelines

- 1. Open to established public schools in Hawaii on the islands of Oahu, Maui and Molokai, service students from middle school through college. Grant recipients must be legal nonprofit entities.
- 2. Grants must be used for student education purposes in the sciences (examples: to purchase equipment, tools, educational and resource materials, supplies and support for programs that foster educational excellence).
- 3. Travel expenses may be allowable provided such costs are incurred to support the science education program and <u>do not exceed non-travel program costs</u>. If you are applying for this grant to offset travel expenses, you must complete Section II of the grant application.
- 4. Not eligible: Activities for the purpose of further religious doctrine; memorials or endowments; non-science projects; fundraisers; wages and salaries; and past purchase.
- 5. Only one grant request per project. This year's <u>application deadlines are March 1 and September 1</u>, 2023.
- 6. Minimum grant request is \$500; maximum is \$1,000.
- 7. Funds must be used for its stated purpose within a 12-month period from the date cash grant is distributed to grantee.
- 8. All grants will be administered in a non-discriminatory manner with regard to race, color, gender, religion, sexual orientation, national origin, disability or veteran status.

Application Process

- 1. Complete and submit the attached grant application form. Application forms are also available at hawaii.bayer.us/education.
- 2. Applications must include <u>complete</u> information as requested, including documentation of item costs. Providing website addresses to online catalogs is not sufficient.
- 3. Application will be reviewed by the Bayer Fund Hawaii Science Education Grant committee. The committee may request additional information if necessary.
- 4. Applicants will receive notification on whether or not their application was approved approximately 10 weeks after application deadline. The Bayer Fund has sole discretion on all application decisions.
