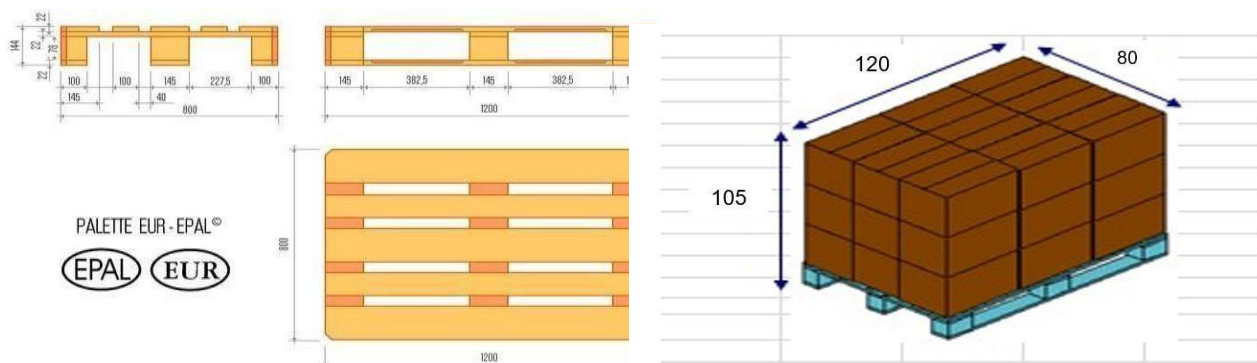

DELIVERY CONDITIONS:

1. The goods must be delivered on pallets according to European Homologation which are qualified to use in automated warehouses. The following dimensions are required: 120 x 80 x 105 mm (breadth x depth x height). Norm EUR.

The maximum height of the palletized goods (including the height of the pallet) is 105 cm and the maximum weight per pallet 600 Kg.



2. The pallets need to have a **thermal protection treatment**.



3. The **pallets** should be **clean, news, in good conditions** and should be wrapped and strapped correctly in order to not dump and fall down. They should only contain units of a unique product and batch. The collocation and protection of the cardboard boxes must be appropriate (must not be protrude beyond the pallet) shaping one compact and stable block. If the goods are remount, it must be able to be unloaded at once in a safe way.
4. The goods must be unloadable from a loading dock with a pallet truck, not with a bull. It will not be unloaded from the side or on the street.
5. Contemporaneously with the good's delivery, the certificates of analysis and/or the conformity of each delivered batch and its components must be sent. If the certificate physically accompanies the goods, it must be presented at the warehouse office at the time of unload. The certificate must be according to the specifications of procurement.
6. The goods have to be identified with a label (visibly on the cardboard boxes) with the following information:
 - Article description
 - Units per parcel and cardboard boxes
 - Batch
 - Date of expiry
 - Article code determined by Bayer
 - Order number of Bayer
 - Supplier name
7. The delivery order must contain the same information as the label.
8. CMR is required for international transports. This must go with a commercial document (packing list or invoice) with the following documents:
 - PO
 - Supplier
 - Shipping address
 - Pallets number
 - Total amount of goods
 - Transport and storage conditions if are required (<5°C, 2° - 8°C)
 - The CoA must be goes with the good or have send before by e-mail to the contact address (purchasing department)
9. The **same delivery doesn't be** separated in **different transports**, except it was accepted before. Only the deliveries that require controlled temperatures (data logger inside) and when no more than ten days have passed since the first delivery will be separated. In that case, different receptions will be considered.
10. Meet and food industries trucks (of unpackaged fresh products) cannot be used (neither truck with butcher hooks). **Vehicles will be closed** (neither open and closed with truck tarp)



11. Deliveries with **more than one supplier batch** must be **previously accepted** by the relevant purchasing contact
12. At the time of unloading any **raw material**, it must be within 80% of its shelf life. Otherwise, the goods cannot be accepted unless prior notification has been given.

Any goods received with different specifications are sent back to its origin in order to receive the correct one.
