Reason for update: General review

Pallet

Type: CP-1 HT Pallet

• Cover: Shrink-wrapped, wound or stretched and/or banded

• Banded by wrapping tapes: covering on the top with a firm board

Max Height: 1.85 m

Note: Plastic film under the bottom boards of the pallet is prohibited

Weight: max. 1000 kg

Stacking Recommendation: No overlap/double stacking

Pallet Load Compliance: Must not exceed the pallet perimeter

Rolls

- **Packaging Requirements:**
 - a. Each roll must be protected with dustproof material (PE or PP films)
 - b. Light sensitive films should be additionally packed to protect them from light
 - c. Polyvinylalcohol (PVAL) films and other water vapour sensitive films must be packed in water vapour tight packages
 - d. Rolls of film stacked one on top of the other must be protected with plastic foam mats or cardboard discs
- Max Weight per Dispatch Unit: 50 kg
- Labeling:
 - a. The roll of film must have identification labels on both the package and the core
- **Orientation:**
 - a. The rolls must be delivered standing on pallets

Quantity

Number per pallet: To be determined based on the respective article reference



Pallet Labeling

- Label Placement: One label on each narrow side and one on a long side
- Label Content:
 - o Bayer Material Number and Product Name
 - o Bayer Order Number
 - o Quantity per Pallet
 - o Date of Production
 - o Batch No.
 - o Supplier Name
 - o Supplier Internal Information
- **Note:** Any deviations must be agreed upon with the receiving site
