General

- **Note:** Any necessary deviations must be pre-approved by the Crop Science Division / PS-AIM-CPI-PQFP-F&P and coordinated with local sites. Only one type of packaging is permitted per pallet. Protective accessories are considered disposable und must comply with EU Regulation 2025/40
- **Reason for update:** General review

Pallet/Palletization

- Type: CP-1 HT or CP-3 HT/CP-9 HT depending on FIBC size/shape, any other specific requirements must be agreed with receiving sites
- Cover: Shrink-wrapped, wound or stretched and/or banded depending on the reference and in agreement with receiving site
- Note: Plastic film under the bottom boards of the pallet is prohibited
- Pallet Load Compliance: Must not exceed the pallet perimeter
- Pallet height: Pallet should not exceed a height of 1.85m, any other specific requirements must be agreed with receiving sites
- **Stacking:** Pallets must be stackable (1 + 1)

FIBC

- **Orientation:** all FIBC needs to be oriented in the same direction and perfectly aligned
- **Appearance:** Before delivery pallets need to be protected against rain and dirt

Pallet Labeling

- Label Placement: One label on each narrow side and one on a long side
- **Label Content:**
 - o Bayer Material Number and Product Name
 - o Bayer Order Number
 - o Quantity per Pallet
 - o Date of Production
 - o Batch No.
 - Supplier Name
 - o Supplier Internal Information
- Note: Any deviations must be agreed upon with the receiving site
