



What is SURPASS?

In 2019 as part of our "Raising the Bar" sustainability commitments, Bayer announced that in future, we intend to only sell crop protection products in developing countries that meet both the safety standards of that local market and the principles of safety standards of a majority of reference regulatory authorities including the US, Canada, Brazil, EU, Australia, New Zealand, Japan and China. To act upon this commitment, we launched project SURPASS: Sustainability and Responsibility improving Policies for Action in Safety Standards.


What is the objective of SURPASS?

The objective of SURPASS is to ensure that across the globe there is no unacceptable risk for farmers when applying our products according to the label, no unacceptable risk to consumers (food safety) and no unnecessary harm to the environment. In the effort to define stringent safety standards for the use of crop protection products, at Bayer we apply additional safety standards on top of the regulatory requirements in many countries where we register our products.




How is SURPASS implemented?

All new projects ideas are routinely screened for their safety profile. We follow a risk-based approach that considers both the exposure and the toxicological potential. We use an internally developed automated risk assessment tool called QuickScan to evaluate product safety.

SURPASS is transparent

As transparency is a key element for SURPASS, we will publish our safety standards on our transparency website. Our operator safety standard was published in 2021, and other safety standards will be published in the coming years.



Bayer's Safety Standards


